

100% Club Presidents Award Requirements

The rules for the 2011-2012 Club President's Award are:

1. The Club shall comply with the Association Constitution and By-laws and the Policies of the International Board of Directors and shall refrain from any action encouraging unauthorized use of the name, goodwill, emblem, the marks Lions, Lions Club, Lion International and other insignias of the association.
2. The club must have conducted at least one (1) major service activity during the Year in line with the International Program.
3. The club must achieve one of the following:
 Show a net increase in the club membership for the fiscal year.
 Sponsor a new Lion or Leo Club during the fiscal year.
 Qualified for the Club Retention Award.
4. The club does not have an unpaid balance of over US\$50.00 owed to International Headquarters as of March 31, 2012.
5. The club has submitted the following three (3) reports to International Headquarters:
 Monthly Membership Report (C-23-A)
 Annual Activities Report (A-1)
 Annual Club Officers Report (PU – 101)
6. The president has attended the following Lions meeting during the year:
 At least two (2) zone meetings
 Club officer's school
 District, multiple district, or international convention
7. The club president must certify that all new members have been properly inducted, indoctrinated and involved by assignment to a working activity or service requirement.
8. The club has conducted a club retreat during the year. (Questions regarding the criteria accepted for the retreat may be discussed with the District Governor prior to completing the application form from International).

In order to be eligible for the President's Excellence Award, the President must have been recommended to the 2011 – 2012 District Governor by the Zone Chairman or Region Chairman. The District Governor must have certified the President as having met all the requirements thereof. Such certifications must be mailed to the International Office within 20 days after the close of the International Convention.
