

## International Peace Poster Contest 2011 - 2012

“**Children Know Peace**” is the theme of the 2011 – 2012 Peace Poster Contest. Lions clubs can sponsor the program in their community for children in local schools or organized, sponsored youth groups. Students, ages 11, 12, or 13 on November 15, are eligible to participate. Through the contest, students are encouraged to visually depict their interpretation of the contest’s theme.

Sponsoring clubs must purchase a contest kit for each participating school or youth group. For 2011-2012, the cost of each kit is \$9.95 plus shipping, handling and taxes. Each kit includes:

- Official club contest guide and rules
- Official school or youth group contest guide and rules
- Participant flyer which may be duplicated and given to each participating student to take home
- District Governor Postcard to notify the district governor of your club’s participation
- Certificates for contest winner and school or youth group

Kits should be ordered as soon as possible to guarantee sufficient time for a well-planned contest. Please allow 3-4 weeks for delivery.

### Important Deadlines for the 2011-2012 Peace Poster Contest:

**October 1, 2011** - Deadline to purchase kits.

**November 15, 2011** - Postmark deadline for a club to send one winning poster (per contest sponsored) to the district governor.

**December 1, 2011** - Postmark deadline for the governor to send one winning district poster to multiple district council chairman.

**December 15, 2011** - Postmark deadlines for one multiple District winners to be sent to the Public Relations Department at International Headquarters.

**February 1, 2012** - International winners will be notified on or before this date.

Clubs are encouraged to honor their winning participants in a meaningful fashion. District entries will be displayed and the district winner recognized at the District Convention.
